
Joker Board “Find the Joker”

The Game...

- The object of the game is to find the Joker card on the Joker Board.
- The Joker Board itself consists of a locked board containing 53 cards from a pack of playing cards. This includes one Joker card. At the start of the game (week 1) all the cards are face down.
- In subsequent weeks the board will consist of cards turned by previous winning ticket holders (who did not find the joker) and the remaining cards will still be face down.
- The Joker Board is on display in the Club at all times and is locked.
- You must be a fully paid-up member to turn a card with a chance to win the prize money.
- The game takes place every Friday evening, last ticket sales at 7pm with the draw taking place at 7.15pm.
- Draw tickets are on sale from the preceding Monday. Tickets are sold each week and are entered into the draw. Each Ticket costs £1. A member can buy as many tickets as they wish.
- The game continues each Friday with the prize pot increasing if not won the previous week.
- Once the Joker is found the Joker Board is reset.

The Draw...

- From all the tickets purchased from the preceding Monday a ticket is randomly drawn.
- The holder of the drawn ticket wins the bottle prize for that evening.
- The winner then gets invited to turn a card on the Joker Board to try to find the Joker.
- The chosen card is turned, if the Joker is found, the winner wins the Jackpot. If the Joker is not found the jackpot rolls over to the following week and combined with further ticket sales increases the jackpot for the following week. The turned card then remains face up on the board.
